We want you to get involved and design a square patch that will join a host of others to make a giant patchwork which will be proudly displayed in the theatre foyer for all to see and enjoy!

Instructions

Step 1

Think about why you love going to the Theatre. It could be;

- A past show you've seen
- A feeling you get when you go to the Theatre
- A vivid memory from a previous trip
- A word or line from your favourite play or show, or the title of your favourite show
- Someone you go to the Theatre with
- Or anything that makes you feel good!

Feeling inspired?

Step 2

Express your idea on a 10cm x 10cm square patch of fabric or paper (ensure you leave an extra 1cm boarder all the way round). You don't need to be a prize winning artist to take part – just have fun and share your memory with us!

You can express yourself in a variety of ways:

Draw it, Stitch it, Print it, Paint it, Write it, Stick it or even **Photograph it**

And you can take as little or as much time as you like on this!

Step 3

Send your fabric patch to us in the post to Patchomime, Camberley Theatre, Knoll Road, Camberley, Surrey, GU15 3HD.

Don't forget to tell us your name and include a short paragraph about what your square means to you.

Or you can upload your image to our website and we will print it or forward to someone who can put this on fabric for you. Head to camberleytheatre.co.uk/patchomime for more information.
